

Alleged Traitor Committed for Trial

John Pappi, a Hungarian, was taken off the train yesterday by Immigration Inspector Geo. Thomas, and turned over to the Provincial Police. It is claimed that he went over from Wexland to New York on Thursday, with over \$700 collected among his compatriots there to be sent to Hungary.

This morning he came up before Police Magistrate Fraser, and was committed for trial. Only formal evidence was taken, and the documents exhibited. Mr. Cowper appeared for the prosecution and Mr. H. McCool for the defence. The charge is treason by aiding the alien enemy.
