

GERMANS ARRESTED AT CARLETON PLACE

Suspected of Attempting to Damage a Munitions Plant at Pembroke

Pembroke, Ont., March 14.—Ernest Hartscher and Arthur Zinker were taken from the train at Carleton Place and brought back here on suspicion of having attempted to damage a local munitions plant early Monday morning. Hartscher has been identified by the guard who fired up on him while attempting to enter the plant. They admitted they were Germans from Berlin, Ont., and had been in town since Friday, ostensibly looking for work. Their grips, which were checked through to Galt, are being brought here for inspection.
