

Stiff Sentences For Traitors

The case of the four Austrians charged with sending money to Austria came up for trial yesterday in Welland before Judge Livingstone. The man who took the money to Buffalo, Todor Mihil, was let go, having turned king's evidence. The others, George Margureson, John Haban and Vasele Spermezon, were fined \$100 and one month's imprisonment, and failing the payment of the fine an additional three month's imprisonment. The man who took the money to the agent in Buffalo was caught at the bridge by Mr. John Donahue of the immigration department and he and Mr. Hunt of the department gave evidence yesterday.
