Wants British To Clean City Streets

Armorer Sergt. A. Byles, of the 108th Battalion, expressed indignation, in an interview today, on account of the aliens employed by the city in cleaning the streets.

"I walked around the city today and saw gangs of Austrians and Germans picking at snow banks and ice while they gibbered in Austrian and German," he said. "What I would like to know is why the city does not employ British subjects who are ineligible for war service?

The internment camp at Brandon

is full of such persons as are now engaged in cleaning our streets. Anyone who does not believe what I say can go and speak to some of the men so employed and find out that he cannot speak the English language. It's a shame!"
