

# TO EMPLOY ALIEN ENEMIES ON CONSTRUCTION OF ROAD FROM QUEBEC TO VALCARTIER

Quebec, March 30.—Following a conference held yesterday afternoon between Sir Lomer Gouin, premier of Quebec, Col. McBain, and the Hon. Casgrain, F.M.G., it was decided that an asphalt road will be built between the city of Quebec and the concentration camp at Valcartier. The heavy traffic of war automobile trucks and all the other concentration paraphernalia decided the authorities to build a road that will stand the test.

The cost of the new road will be around \$125,000, the larger part of which will be borne by the Quebec provincial roads department. Work is to be started as soon as the snow melts and it is expected alien enemies will be mostly employed.
