Withdraw Charge of Sedition Against Father Fillipow

The charge of sedition against the Rev. Father Anastasius Fillipow, a priest of the Basilian order of the Ruthenian Catholic church, who was alleged to have advised Austrians to leave Canada and join the Teutonic forces, was withdrawn by the military authorities in the provincal police court Tuesday afternoon.

T. J.
