Kingston, April 13.—Lieut. Felix Orb, an interned German prisoner of war here, has contributed two dollars to the Kingston fund for buying comforts for Canadian prisoners in Germany. He writes to the American Consul that he appreciates the fact that the Canadians are fighting as soldiers, and is grateful for his splendid treatment while at Rockwood Hospital, to which he was removed when his health became impaired by overstudy in Fort Henry **internment** camp.
