

Algoma Steel Company at Full Capacity Increases Wages of Many Employees

FINE PROSPECTS THAT THE INDUSTRIES WILL CONTINUE ALONG THE PRESENT SATISFACTORY LINES

Citizens of the city will be pleased at the announcement posted by the Algoma Steel Company, that, commencing May 25, the rate for common labor will be increased to twenty cents per hour.

Until further notice a bonus of ten percent will be given to all employees, except those on a straight salary basis and some of these are raised to a

certain extent. The amount of this bonus will be added to the pay checks when they are issued.

A similar bonus will be given to all employees on a straight salary, where the salary does not exceed \$125 per month.

The mills are now running at full capacity, with fine prospects of their continuing to do so.
