

STRIKERS MAKING PROGRESS, REPORT

No Man Breaking From Ranks and There Is Money In Treasury

Progress made by the teamsters in their strike against the transfer companies was reported at the meeting of the Trades and Labor Council held Thursday evening.

Following are some of the salient points of this report:

Every man is holding firm. There is no chance of a break from union ranks.

The strikers have more than \$1,000 cash on hand to meet current expenses.

In addition the Street Carmen have voted \$1,000 to the strikers. This will be paid in weekly instalments of \$250 and it is intimated that more will be forthcoming if needed.

Strike breakers are getting \$3 a day and their board and lodging.

Many business firms are helping the strikers by refusing to accept goods delivered by non-union men.

The first 11 strike breakers brought in by the company were aliens.

Many of the strike breakers imported from all over Canada desert as soon as they arrive in Winnipeg.

There also was a report from the financial committee showing how money is being raised to help the strikers.
