

# SAID HUNS IN STATES WERE COMING ACROSS

Interned Austrians Were Told They  
Would Soon be Freed by Ger-  
man-Americans.

St. Catharines, Ont. Aug. 12.—A probe into the cause of the refusal of sixty-five Austrians from Kapuskasing internment camp to work on the Welland Ship Canal, has resulted in the discovery of the fact that an educated Austrian whose word was believed, informed the prisoners at the camp that Austrians and Germans from the United States would soon free them and the British government would be forced to pay them \$5 per day for the time spent in custody.
