

THREE CAPTURED; FOURTH IS KILLED

Short Liberty For Four German Prisoners Escaping From In- ternment Camp

AMHERST, N.S., Aug. 25—Three of the four German prisoners who escaped from the internment camp here on Wednesday have been recaptured and the fourth is dead. Two had been hiding near the experimental farm at Nappan, and when other prisoners left their work at the farm, a guard was posted in the cook house. Some hours later two of the escaped Germans opened the cook house door, and were at once ordered to surrender. One did so, but the other ran away. The guard ordered him to halt, but he kept on. Then the guard opened fire and shot him dead.

The four men who escaped were from the crew of the German steamer Kaiser Wilhelm's crew, and they have been the cause of much trouble at the camp.
