

Disapprove Protest On Alien Homesteads

The request of the Yorkton board of Trade urging the Dominion government not to grant free homesteads to aliens, met with disapproval by the members of the Winnipeg Board of Trade Friday afternoon. The board took no action, claiming the government's policy at the present time met this situation fully.

Committees were appointed to make arrangements for an informal entertainment for the members of the Dominion Royal Commission Thanksgiving night. The board, according to A. E. Boyle, secretary, will arrange to have the commission sit in Winnipeg the following day.

Three representatives from the Board of Trade were appointed as members of the Civic Improvement Council.
