## German Prisoners Removed to Amherst

HALIFAX, N.S., Oct. 13.—All the German prisoners who have been for months interned at the citadel here have now been removed to the prisoners camp at Amherst.

The day before evacuation of the local quarters it was found that six men were missing. A very careful search was organized, and they were found in the loft of one of the buildings at the citadel. They had an oil stove and a supply of provisions sufficient to last for several days if necessary.

The six men were handcuffed for the journey to Amherst. One of the six, an officer, was highly indignant at being attached to a plebian prisoner, but, under the circumstances, there could be no discrimination. The whole company of prisoners presented a well-fed and well groom-

ed appearance.
