

THREE HUNDRED ENTERED CANADA HERE LAST MONTH

Rejects Reduced by Govern- ment Action to Relieve Labor Situation

There were 300 admits and 25 rejects of immigrants coming from the States and entering Canada through the Soo for the month of October. The number of rejects has decreased on account of the government giving orders to let all laboring men that is possible come into the country in order to offset the scarcity of labor. A large number of lumbermen came in during the month, but the employment bureaus cannot commence to meet the demand for lumbermen this year. The money qualification necessary on entering Canada has been laid aside for the present.
