

QUIET AT FERNIE

No New Developments in the Strike Situation.

FERNIE, B. C., Dec. 2.—No new developments in the strike situation transpired today, and it was in accord with the decision reached that the Fernie miners have remained idle. The Michel miners and all others in the Pass camps of Alberta resumed work, however, and Fernie is expected, as promised, to resume work Monday morning. Apart from this camp the Lethbridge miners were the only ones reported idle in the district, it being understood an old local grievance which has remained unsettled since the last war bonus controversy, has again risen and angered the men to the point of their refusing to resume work.

President Graham and international board member Rees, en route home from Ottawa, will likely visit Lethbridge Sunday and insist upon an early return to work, to permit the settlement of the present war bonus complications and the adjustment of the local grievance later on.
