

Will Rush Work On Big Aqueduct

Every effort will be made to complete the Shoal Lake aqueduct on time, the water board members decided Monday afternoon in special session. Owing to difficulty in obtaining enough men to handle the contracts satisfactorily this season, labor restrictions will be removed next year, it was decided. These restrictions provided that employes must be residents of the district. During the 1917 season outside laborers will be employed. British subjects will be first preferred. Interned aliens will be barred.

The offices of the corporation will be moved to the fifth floor of The Tribune building, Jan. 1. Several large accounts were paid. They totalled \$139,079.19.
