U. S. CONSULS HERE GIVE UP CHARGES

German Prisoners Held in Canada
Must Look to Swiss
Representatives.

Representatives of the American

Government in all parts of Canada have been notified that subjects of Germany are not to be looked after by American Consuls. Up to a few weeks ago the interests of the German prisoners in Canada have been attended by the American representatives in Canada.

Several prisoners of war, who were

apprehended in this district, and who have been placed in Fort Henry, have been under the supervision of the American Consul in Kingston. He has investigated carefully all their complaints and their many wants have been given serious consideration.

The prisoners in Fort Henry will now come under the charge of the Swiss Consul General at Montreal. There are at least 500 Germans at Kingston, and the Swiss Consul will

probably establish an office in Kingston.
