

NEW RULE AT BORDER

Americans to Issue Identification Cards

Canadian Press Despatch.

Washington, March 26.—For the convenience of thousands of persons who have occasion to cross the Canadian line daily at Detroit and other places, and the Mexican line, the Department of Labor will initiate a new identification system to go into effect with the new immigration law, May 1.

A card like a railroad pass on which will appear the name of the bearer, his signature, description and photograph, will be used. Those who have frequent need to cross the line will be provided with cards at once, 15,000 of which are now being prepared for immediate use.
