

# ALIEN ENEMY GRIEVANCES

## Returned Soldiers in Toronto Make Requests

Toronto, April 17.—Mayor Church and Chief of Police Grasset, late this afternoon met representatives of the war veterans with a view of settling the grievances regarding alien enemies, which have led to recent raids on restaurants and factories. Captain Sinclair, provost marshal of the city, and Captain Widgery, of Exhibition camp, were present.

The returned soldiers asked that steps be taken to prevent the importation of enemy alien labor, their employment on public works, and their internment when found, also co-operation in inspecting such places. They also ask for a civic bureau for the benefit of the returned men.

The mayor promised to take the matter up with Ottawa and the civic authorities. In the meanwhile a brief truce was agreed to.
