

10,000 REGISTER NAMES TUESDAY; 50,000 EXPECTED

Canadian Women Active To Help Balance of Power Go- ing To Aliens

Nearly 10,000 Winnipeg citizens registered for the provincial voters' list Tuesday, the proportion of men and women being about equal, according to information received at the central information office, Lindsay block, today. It is expected that 10,000 more will register today, and that a rush will set in Thursday evening.

According to an estimate made by the clerk of the provincial executive council today, there will be at least 50,000 registrations in the city by the time the booths close at 10 o'clock Friday evening.

Many Women Register

Everything indicates that the women will turn out in large numbers, the officials say, and there is much speculation as to whether there will be a larger male or female vote when the lists are completed.

The registration declaration is so simple that there has been comparatively little trouble over it at any of the booths. Clerks report that the women are quite willing to declare that they are of the full age of 21, and that many of them are relieved when informed that they do not have to state their exact age.

Canadian Women Active

In the north end there is a large registration of wives and daughters of naturalized Canadians. Native Canadian women are responding quickly to the warning of the Political Education league that if they do not register the balance of political power may swing to the alien element.

The great majority of inquiries received at the information office, Lindsay block, are being received from women.
