

BURRELL IN NANAIMO

Big Meeting Gives Minister Good Hearing—Applause Is Frequent.

NANAIMO, B. C., Dec. 8.—A largely attended meeting held here last night in the interests of J. C. McIntosh, the Unionist candidate in the Nanaimo federal riding, was addressed by Hon. Martin Burrell, F. C. Stackpool of Victoria, Senator Planta of Nanaimo, Major Harvey of Esquimalt and the candidate. All the speakers were given good receptions and the meeting was free from interruption, the various speakers being frequently applauded.

The Unionist candidate was given a rousing reception and stated that if

elected he would do his utmost to have legislation enacted looking to the placing of the burden of providing the needed finances upon the shoulders of those most able to bear it, and was also in favor of alien enemies either being interned or paid \$1.10 a day and the balance of their earnings placed in a fund for returned soldiers or their dependents.
