

FERNIE MINERS DECIDE TO BURY THE HATCHET

End Eight Months' Row by
Deciding to Recognize
Union Principles.

Fernie, Feb. 23.—District 18 of the Union of Mine Workers of America after the close of a day's strenuous debate over a controversy which has for the past eight months threatened to disrupt the efforts of sixteen years' vigorous labor effort in District 18, to maintain a recognized labor body among the mine workers to advance their standards of living and working conditions for all time, yesterday decided to bury the hatchet. They say they will religiously adhere to the principles for which they have obligated themselves, in so far as the International Trade Union movement is concerned.
