People who start such rumors should be rounded up by the authorities and shot, because they are agents of Germany. People who repeat them should be interned, because they are assisting

German propaganda.

It is the duty of every patriotic Canadian to repudiate any such rumors and to give the police the name of any person who repeats them. Readers are invited to give The Tribune the name and address of all persons circulating such reports—The Tribune will see that the information is placed in the hands of the proper authorities.

The people can depend upon the newspapers publishing in full all authentic reports. Every word of every official statement issued at field headquarters, in France, at London, Paris, or Washington is printed here. The newspapers are withholding no information and THERE IS NO SOURCE OF AUTHENTIC NEWS THAT IS NOT REACHED BY THE NEWSPAPERS. So-called "private cables" and other such underground sources, through which most of the "exclusive news" is reported to come, DO NOT EXIST.
