Montreal, April 9.—I. Schaefer, steamship agent, convicted many months ago of supplying tickets to enable enemy aliens to return to the Dual Monarchy, was given three months in jail and fined \$500 or another three months by Mr. Justice Cross to-day. He has been in jail while appeals were pending, since 1914. He formerly acted as a court-house interpreter.
