

ALIENS CALLED OUT.

Eastern Registrar Gets Orders to Cancel Exemptions.

Toronto, May 8.—Word has been received by the Ontario registrar to call out for military service all naturalized aliens of the ages 20, 21 and 22. They had previously been granted exemption from military service under the War Times Elections act. The military service they will be allotted will be non-combatant.

The registrar will also call out former aliens, who have been naturalized since the year 1902 and granted exemption. The aliens called to the colors of the Canadian forces will be only those in medical category "A." Those who were granted exemption by tribunals will probably be permitted rehearings.

No order similar to the Ontario one has yet been received by the registrar at Winnipeg.
