

100 FOREIGNERS ARRESTED AT WINDSOR

Where They Were Making a Demonstration — Found Without Papers.

(Canadian Press Despatch)

Windsor, June 18.—Four hundred foreigners, mostly Austrians and Russians, came here from Ford, Ont., to-day to make a demonstration in favor of one of their number who is under arrest charged with inciting his comrades against registration. When searched by the local police one hundred of them were found lacking their papers of nationality as required by the M. S. A., and are now confined to jail here, to be arraigned on a charge of violating the M. S. A. Some of them had extensive Bolshevik and I. W. W. prop. ganda in their pockets.
