

FOREIGNERS MAKE TROUBLE AT FORD OVER AN ARREST

100 Lacked Paper So Were Arrested--Carry Bolshevik Propaganda

Windsor, Ont., June 18.—Four hundred foreigners, mostly Austrians and Russians, came here from Ford, Ont., today to make a demonstration in favor of one of their number, who is under arrest, charged with inciting his comrades against registration. When seized by the local police, one hundred of them were found lacking their papers of nationality, as required by the M. S. Act, and are now confined to jail here to be arraigned on a charge of violating the M. S. A. Some of them had extensive Bolshevik and I. W. W. propaganda in their pockets.
