

No Foundation For Report

Ottawa, June 26.—According to A. E. Warren, chief operating officer of the Canadian Government Railways, there is no foundation for the report that laborers employed in tearing down the old Intercolonial shops at Moncton have quit work, and that interned alien enemies from the detention camp at Amherst have taken their places.

On being apprised of the report, Mr. Warren immediately telegraphed to the general manager of the C.G.R. at Moncton for particulars. The official replied that he was not

aware of a strike, and that there was no truth in regard to the work being done by interned men.

Mr. Warren stated that interned men were being used at different points on the C.G.R. system, but they were also being employed by other railways.
