

ALIEN "GRUB STRIKE" FAILS

Austrians in Ontario Lumber Camp
Kick Up Over Adoption of Food
Board Orders.

Ottawa, July 25.—A group of Austrians employed in a lumber camp in Northern Ontario, threatened a "grub strike" because the company attempted to put in force the regulations of the Canada Food Board applicable to public eating places.

At the request of the Food Board the case was investigated by the Dominion Police, who cautioned them that they must continue to work or be interned.
