

# Alien Lumberjacks Threaten To Strike For Better Food

OTTAWA, July 25—A group of Austrians employed in a lumber camp in northern Ontario threatened a "grub strike" because the company attempted to put in force the regulations of the Canada Food board. There are some 30 Austrians in the camp, of whom, however, a few only were active in planning the strike.

The case was investigated by the Dominion police and when it was found that the men were receiving sufficient wholesome food and that their only grievance was the adoption of the Food board regulations, the Dominion police cautioned them that they must continue to work or be interned.

The warning has been effective and the threatened "grub strike" did not develop.
