

## COURT INTERPRETER'S LIFE THREATENED.

Brantford, Aug. 16.—The life of Louis Stander, the well-known Brantford Police Court interpreter, has been threatened by the Bolsheviki. Stander received a letter post-marked Hamilton, stating that he had but a week to live. The letter was anonymous and was in Russian. It followed from the evidence given by the interpreter in the police court Monday when he translated literature seized by the police on which convictions were based for two jail sentences to local Bolsheviki. Stander was informed that he had been interfering with Russian affairs too long, and he could no longer continue to act with impunity. The letter has been turned over to the police with a correct translation of it.
