STREET RAILWAY COMPANY FIRES 35 MLIEN ENEMIES TO GIVE HEROES JOBS

Thirty-five alien enemies employed by the Winnipeg Electric Railway company were dismissed to permit the company to employ returned soldiers, railway officials an-

nounced today. They said no alien enemy was added to the staff since the war began.

The company is advertising for

returned soldiers to fill positions as mechanics, blacksmiths, trackmen and bondsmen.

Twenty-five alien enemies employed by the street commissioner stopped work. They will be replaced by returned men. The men working for the engineer's department laying watermains, who refused to work until they were promised protection, resumed operations today.

The city has re-employed about 75 returned men, some of whom had not worked for the city before the war began. Many meter readers and clerks in the light and power department are returned soldiers.
