

## ALIENS WHO ARE ENEMIES SHOULD BE DEPORTED.

To the Editor of The Tribune.

Sir:—The English-speaking residents of the Glenella district view with alarm the stand taken by the returned men in forcing out of employment the foreigners in the city of Winnipeg, as these foreigners must live somewhere, and, if prevented living in the city, they will, perforce, be compelled to migrate to the smaller towns and the country. We have a great many Germans settled in this district, and the majority are good settlers, and law abiding people, but there are also a great many Germans and Austrians in this district who should have been in an internment camp for the last four years, and who should now be deported, and if this class of foreigners are to be reinforced by the enemy aliens driven out of Winnipeg and the larger towns by the returned men, then life for the Britishers in these districts will not be worth living, and will eventually lead to bloodshed, as we Canadians have borne all we intend from our enemy aliens in this district. One case which happened here shows the strained feeling here between the Pro-German class and the Canadians. The details are known to the local authorities.

Now, what we, the Canadians of this district, desire and demand of the returned men, is that every alien ousted out of a job anywhere in the province of Manitoba, be immediately deported to the country he migrated from, and I may say that the Canadians are right behind the returned men to a man, and will assist the returned men financially or otherwise, to have every undesirable foreigner deported from the country, for, as I said before, if this rabble of undesirable Hun aliens are allowed to spread through the country, there will be bloodshed. We are at the parting of the ways—it must either be Canada for the Canadians or Canada for the Huns.
