Hamilton, Feb. 8.-At a meeting of the Trades and Labor Council the

following resolution concerning the alien enemies was unanimously passed: "While this council is in sympathy

with the G.W.V.A. in their desire to rid the country of all alien enemies. we feel that the resolution passed by the G.W.V.A. is too drastic, and we cannot see our way clear to endorse the resolution in its entirety. We do

go on record as favoring the deportation of all alien enemies who were interned, and who, by word or deed,

have proved themselves disloyal to this country, and who are otherwise known to be dangerous, but that

other alien enemies be allowed to leave the country at their pleasure.

We also favor the deportation of all
