

# **MUCH ALIEN LABOR NEEDED IN CANADA**

---

**Soldiers Are Warned to Go Slow in  
Demanding Their Deportation.**

---

Sydney, N.S., Feb 13.—An appeal to returned soldiers to go slow in their demands for the deportation of aliens was made by Major J. W. Maddin, provincial president for Nova Scotia of the G.W.V.A., in a manifesto issued here this morning. Major

Maddin reminds the veterans that a vast majority of these aliens are engaged in labor which the average Canadian-born citizen considers beneath him and will not do. He forecasts great industrial expansion, in which low class labor is impera-

five, and if the aliens now here are deported others will have to be allowed in again. The manifesto concludes with an appeal to respect the constituted authorities and to present grievances through the proper channels.
