

POLES WHO HOLD PASSPORTS NEED NOT REPORT NOW

Polish people with satisfactory passports, will in future be relieved of the necessity of reporting to the police as required under the order-in-council regarding aliens.

Chief of Police R. C. Vincent yesterday received the following letter from J. A. Cawdron, Acting Chief Commissioner of Police at Ottawa.

"I am enclosing herewith a copy of a new passport being issued by the Polish council in Canada to such Poles as may satisfy them regarding their loyalty in this country, and will deem it a favor if you will arrange to grant any person being bona fide owner of such a passport, exemption from reporting in accordance with paragraph II, order-in-council 1908."

Chief Vincent says that already there are several of these passports that have been presented in the city and have been honored.
