

AUSTRIANS FIGURED IN MONTREAL TROUBLE

Nine Enemy Aliens Break Parole and Will be Interned

MONTREAL, May 3.—As a sequel to the May Day demonstration on the Champ de Mars and in a public meeting held at night when certain indiscreet aliens evinced too much sympathy with the lands they had turned their backs in bygone years, nine of them have been arrested by Captain J. N. Carter, registrar of enemy aliens, and are being interned. These men are all Austrians who have enjoyed liberty on parole during the war.
