FORM BIG UNION

Winnipeg Veterans Tell of Plan by Which They Propose Forcing Action Against Enemy Aliens.

WINNIPEG, May 14.—A new element has been introduced into the labor situation in Winnipeg. Returned soldiers are demanding the immediate expulsion or internment of enemy aliens and have informed the heads of local organized labor that unless enemy aliens are expelled from the trades unions, the Great War Veterans will form "One Big Union" of their own.

Three aliens, Wasyl Ptaszynski, Nick. Skotniski and Pete Getyl, brought before Judge Myres yesterday afternoon by the Great War Veterans' Association as a test for deportation, were interned by order of the judge. Judge Myres stated that he had no jurisdiction in ordering their deportation, but that he would order them to be interned. This he stated would be done throughout Canada, and it would then be up to

the military authorities to decide whether they would be deported or not.

The aliens were then handed over to officers of the R. N. W. M. P., who will see to their internment.
