

# ALIENS TO BE TRIED IN COURT

A summary trial will be granted the four men of foreign birth held at the immigration hall on charges of seditious conspiracy, A. J. Andrews, K.C., counsel for the Dominion government, announced this afternoon.

"The government is making arrangements to give the men a hearing before a judge of the county court," he said. "The judge has not yet been named, therefore we don't know the exact date of the hearing."

According to Mr. Andrews, the ruling of the judge will be final. If the men are convicted, they will be deported as undesirables, he said.

Marcus Hyman, counsel for the men, declared that he had been notified that the plan to bring the men before a board of inquiry headed by Thomas Gelley, assistant immigration commissioner, had been abandoned. He had not heard of the new plan to arraign the men before a judge.

J. Berenczuk, a returned soldier, held with the others, was released from custody this morning. Berenczuk was examined as to his sanity, but the result was not announced.

The four men to be tried by a judge are: Matthew Charitonoff, Moses Almozoff, B. Devyatkin and Sam Blumenberg.
