

WILL NEVER HAIL

ENEMY AS BROTHER

Labor Told to Clean House Before Approaching Veterans

NEW GLASGOW, N. S., July 18.—

The Great War Veterans' Association of Nova Scotia will never hail any enemy alien brother nor enter into formal relations or co-operation with any organization which includes alien enemy or those of alien enemy extraction in its ranks. That point was made clear here yesterday at the provincial convention which developed marked hostility to affiliation with the Trades and Labor Councils until the labor unions amend their constitution so as to purge their ranks of all aliens of enemy nationality.

The discussion was precipitated by a speech of J. H. Vanduren, president of the Sydney Trades and Labor Council, who had not been asked to address the convention.
