

RETURNED MEN AS INTERMEDIATES IN THE COBALT STRIKE; ALIENS EXCLUDED

Plain Speaking at Meeting
Which Took Place
Yesterday

Cobalt, July 30.—At a meeting of the returned soldiers of the district held in the town hall here yesterday a committee to wait upon the mine Managers' Association and the miners' union was appointed in an effort to obtain some basis for the settlement of the present strike here.

The meeting enthusiastically endorsed a motion calling for the exclusion of all aliens from the mines.

The proceedings, over which Postmaster Walter Binney president, became quite lively at times and there was considerable plain speaking. The press was excluded on a vote taken at the outset of the meeting.

The resolution regarding alien labor follows upon an announcement made by the executive of local G. W. V. A., that the mine managers had agreed to this concession asked for by the Veterans. There have been no other developments in the local situation.
