

4,296 ALIENS PASS THROUGH HANDS OF FOE INVESTIGATION BOARD

The Alien Enemy Investigation board handled 4,296 aliens during the seven months ended Aug. 15, that it operated, according to figures given out today by H. J. Mansfield, former secretary.

Winnipeg office took care of 3,681 and Brandon 615. Of these 432 were refused cards, as being undesirable, 76 undisposed of, and the rest granted cards as follows: red (unnaturalized aliens) 1,653; green, (naturalized allied aliens) 1,164; drab, (naturalized enemy aliens such as Germans and Austrians) 264.

Those who received cards paid in \$4,734 in fees.
