

## NO NEWS OF HINDUS.

### IMMIGRATION DEPARTMENT AND THE BELLINGHAM RIOTS.

The Seven Hundred and Fifty Men  
Heading for **Canada** Will be  
Treated in Precisely the Same  
Way as Any Other Would-be  
Settlers.

Ottawa, Sept. 6.—The Dominion Government has had no information concerning the report that 750 Hindus are on their way from Bellingham, in Washington Territory, for British Columbia, nor as to the raid upon Hindus in Bellingham. The only thing that **Canada** can do to prevent Hindus arriving in **Canada** is to apply to them the terms of the immigration act in the same way as to other British subjects. That is to say, if there are any undesirables among the Hindus they will be deported. Any of them suffering from disease or likely to become a public charge on the community will not be allowed to land in **Canada**. Beyond this, which is applicable to British subjects as well as foreigners, there are no restrictions upon Hindu immigration. The immigration department has no information on the matter.
