

## TOO MANY UNDESIRABLES.

### LABOR COUNCIL UP IN ARMS ON IMMIGRATION QUESTION.

Unions Were Requested to Collect Documentary Evidence—Mr. John H. Kennedy Was Elected President by Acclamation.

The District Labor Council last night passed a resolution protesting against the very **undesirable** class of immigrants that it is alleged is now being brought to Canada. The resolution denounced the Canadian Manufacturers' Association for fostering foreign employment agencies to the detriment of good Canadian workmen. The Council will also apply to the Government for **some** of the printed matter respecting **immigration**, circulated in England, while the delegates were requested to have their respective unions collect documentary evidence of **immigration** by unfair means.

Mr. John H. Kennedy was re-elected President of the Council by acclamation.
