

THE YEAR'S IMMIGRATION.

NEARLY HUNDRED AND FORTY-
SEVEN THOUSAND ARRIVED.

Number From United Kingdom and
United States About Equal —
Figures of the Rejected and De-
ported Immigrants.

Ottawa, April 23.—During the fiscal year ending March 31 last, 146,901 immigrants came to Canada. Of this number 59,901 were of British origin 34,175 continental, and 59,832 from the United States.

During the year 509 undesirable immigrants were rejected at ocean ports and 4,580 at United States boundary points, and 1,748 recent immigrants were deported to the country from whence they came. A total in all of rejected and deported immigrants of 6,837, or more than came to Canada altogether in the last year of the Conservative regime.

Of the 1,166,126 immigrants arriving in Canada in the last ten years 819,213 came from the United Kingdom and the United States.
