
SENDING THEM BACK.

Undesirables Leaving Halifax For Europe.

Halifax, N.S., Dec. 18.—The Federal immigration authorities are strictly enforcing the immigration law and taking every precaution to prevent the entrance of undesirables. What is believed to be the largest number of immigrants ever deported from Canada in one steamer left here Monday, when the Allan liner *Sardinian* sailed for London and Havre with ninety-five undesirables. Sixty of these were Bulgarians. Nearly all the others were suffering from some incurable disease.
