

WERE GALICIANS DEFRAUDED ?

Claim that Quebec Official Got the Better of Them on Tickets.

Quebec, July 27.—Seven Galicians recently arrived in Canada have complained to the steamship company bringing them out that they were defrauded for railway tickets at the Quebec agency of the Dominion immigration department. They claim that on arrival an officer to whom they had entrusted their tickets for western Canada, substituted tickets for Thedford Mines, a short distance from Quebec. They did not notice the substitution until reaching Thedford Mines and have returned here to seek redress.
