

EMPLOYMENT AGENT BROKE IMMIGRATION ACT AND FINED \$50

Mike Rosenthal Appeared in
Court for Neglecting to
Secure a License.

Charged with a violation of the labor section of the Immigration Act, Mike Rosenthal, of the Sault, was found guilty and fined \$50 by Magistrate Mackay yesterday. According to the provisions of an order-in-council recently passed at Ottawa, no agent can employ immigrants without a Dominion license under the Immigration Department, and Mike had been shipping new arrivals out to employers without getting this license.

Under the same provisions the employment agents placing immigrants are required to have a written order from the employers before engaging the men, ~~and~~ required to furnish the men with a schedule of the legitimate expenses that may be deducted from their pay, and also have to give the Immigration Department a list of all the men employed with other information concerning them. None of these provisions were complied with in this instance.
