THE RELEASE OF DULLMAN.
The News says that the convict
Dullman, who was released from
Kingston Penitentiary the other day,
after serving a long sentence for trying to blow up the Welland Canal,

was a sympathizer of the men in the United States who for years have financed and are still financing the home rule movement. "He was a Fenian, and they are largely Fenians. They hate the British Empire just as they hated it when they invaded Canada in 1866 and 1870." Naturally one would expect the News to censure the Dominion Government for releasing Dullman. Instead of that, it blames Liberal newspapers in Canada, because, it says, they "profess something like admiration" for the Americans who had subscribed \$100,000 to finance Redmond's Nationalist army. This partisan ingenuity is hardly exceeded by that of another fournal which contends that the present lack of employment in Canada is really due to the immigration policy of the Laurier Government, which went out of office nearly three years ago.
