

RECALL OF RESERVISTS

No Official Notification Received by German Consul for Victoria as Yet

Mr. A. von Girsewald, acting Imperial consul for Victoria, stated yesterday that he had received no official notification of the recall of German army reserve officers and men, but expected word at any time. He explained that there were at least thirty men of German nationality in Victoria who were subject to recall and he thought they would all respond eagerly. These include men who have not served their time in the army.

As there is no Austrian consulate in Victoria, that office having been incorporated in headquarters at Vancouver some time ago, it is impossible to get reliable information as to the number of Austrian reservists here, but Mr. von Girsewald was of the opinion that there could not be more than two or three.
